Introduction: Matt. 28; Mark 16; John 20 – chronology – FEAT (Hanegraaff)

F E A T

➤ Early Dawn – 24:1

- Sunday – the first day of the week
- Spices – taking the spices they (the women) had prepared

➤ Empty Tomb – 24:2-3

- Found outside: the stone – v. 2 – they found the stone rolled away
- Found inside: no body – v. 3 – they did not find the body of the Lord

➤ Elucidated by angels – 24:4-7

- Radiance – v. 4 – in dazzling apparel
- Rebuke – v. 5 – “Why do you seek the living among the dead?”
- Risen – v. 6-7 – “He is not here, but has risen.”
- Revealed – v. 6-7 – “Remember how he told you, ...”

➤ Effect on the people – 24:8-12

- Remembered – v. 8 – and they remembered his words
- Returned – v. 9 – and returning from the tomb ...
- Reported – v. 9-10 – they told all these things to the eleven and to ...
- Ridiculous – v. 11 – but these words seemed to them an idle tale
- Rejected – v. 11 – and they did not believe them
- Running – v. 12 – But Peter rose and ran to the tomb
- Review – v. 12 – looking in, he saw the linen cloths by themselves

Points of Personal Ponderance (Application for Action):

- ✚ Why and how should I respond to the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ?
- ✚ Have I placed my faith (trust) in Christ alone for my salvation from sin?

How to Respond:

- ❖ Repent (turn) from sin and empty ways of approaching God

- ❖ Rejoice in what God has done to save you
- ❖ Represent God as one of His Own children
