Collapse – of the Temple – v. 5-7

 Intrigue – v. 5 – Mark 13:1 And as he came out of the temple, one of his disciples said to him, "Look, Teacher, what wonderful stones and what wonderful buildings!"

1<sup>st</sup> temple, Solomon 10 centuries B.C., stood 400 years until Babylonians 586 B.C., partially rebuilt under leadership of Zerubbabel during the Persian Empire under Cyrus II early 500's B.C., Herod (the Great) began elaborate and expanded rebuild 20 B.C. – A.D. 18 – thus called Herod's Temple at the times of Jesus and Luke (and now) – completed 64 A.D., one of the ancient wonder of the world, six years before its destruction.
